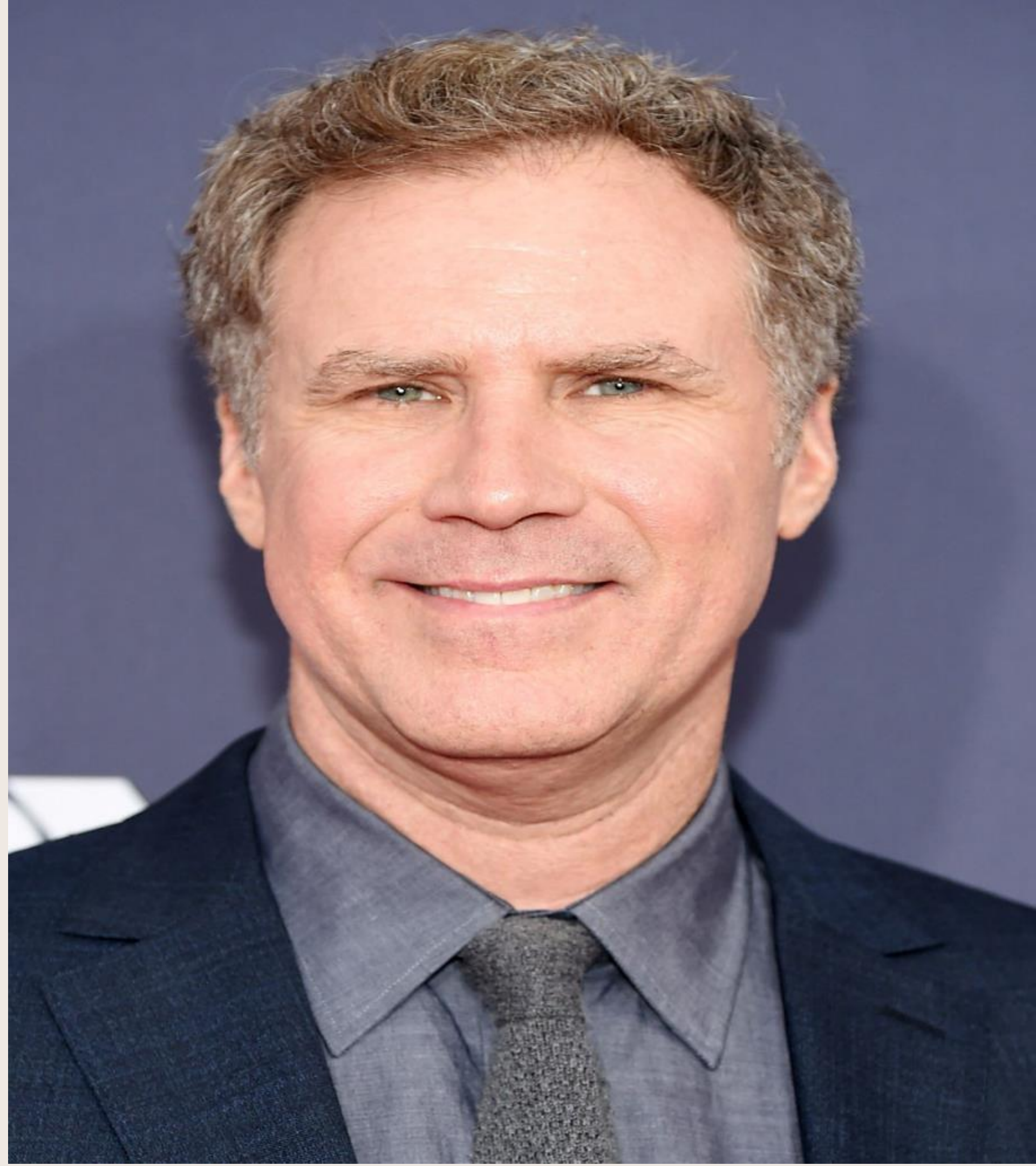
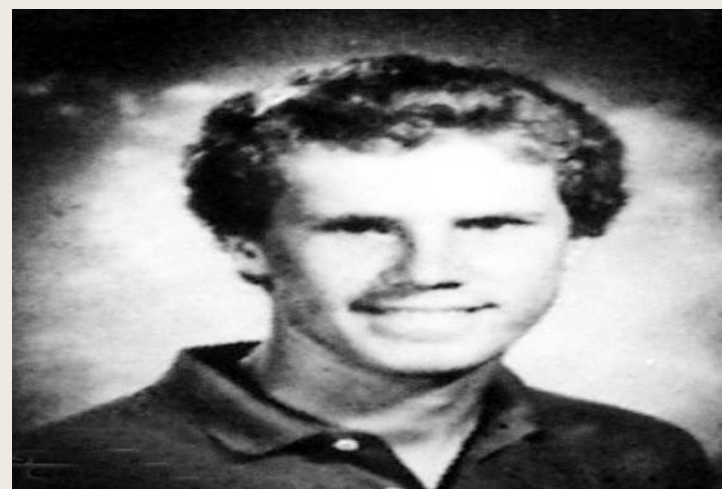
Introduction

 - 'Talladega Nights: The Ballad of Ricky Bobby' (2006).



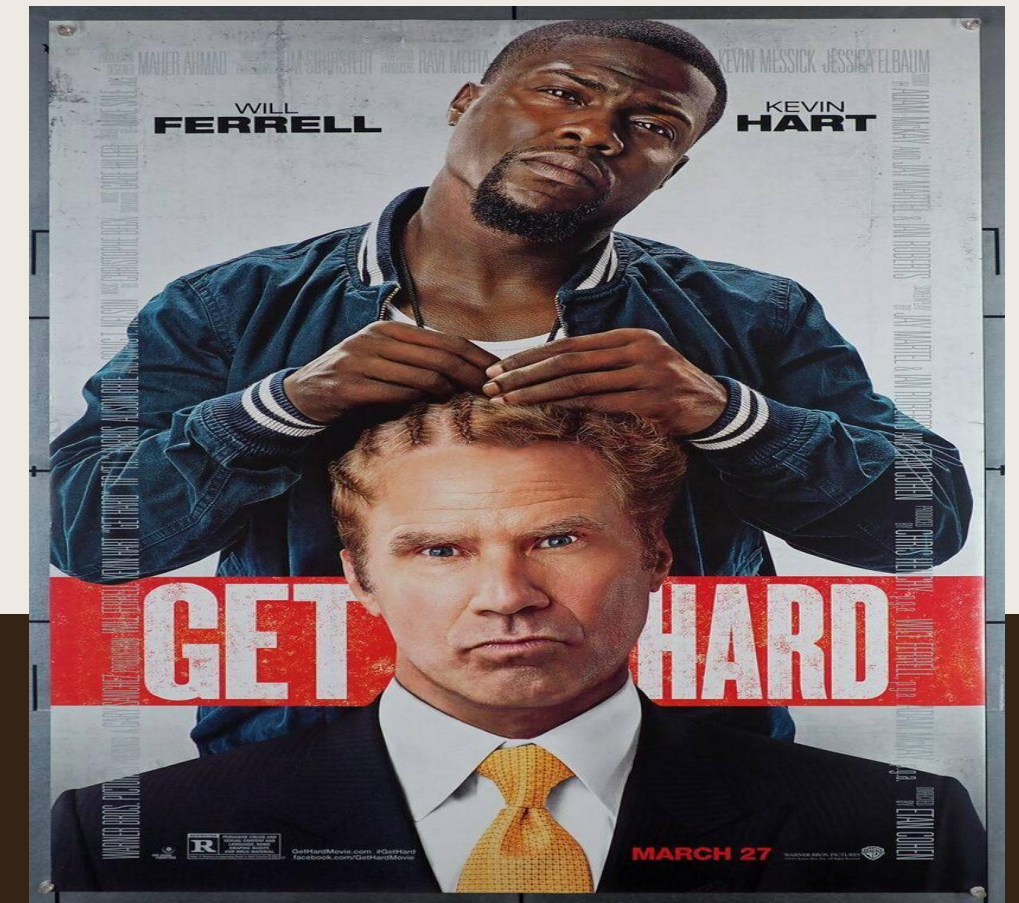
